Church Music Notes

Song of Praise

Our first praise song this morning is **Our God Reigns.** This tuneful gospel praise song was written by Leonard Smith, Jr. This is a scripture song, using Isaiah 52:7: "How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, 'Your God reigns!' " The words also echo 1 Chronicles 16:31-33: "Let the heavens be glad and let the earth rejoice and let the nations say, 'It is the Lord who reigneth!' Our God reigneth! Let the seas roar, let the fields rejoice, let the trees sing at the presence of the Lord."




Another of our praise songs this morning is the hymn, On Jordan's Stormy Banks, hymn number 620. This hymn was first printed in London in the year 1787 under the heading "Heaven Anticipated." The author of the words was Samuel Stennett, born in Exeter England, in 1727. In his adult career, he became a Seventh Day Baptist minister in London, and was a widely respected statesman, taking a strong stand for religious liberty. He also preached in his church regularly on the seventh-day Sabbath, and wrote many sermons, pamphlets, and 38 hymns. The words of the hymn refer to the Children of Israel crossing from the years of wandering in the wilderness, over the Jordan River into the promised land. Of course as Christians, this symbolizes our looking forward to the Second Coming of Jesus, and our eventual transition from this earth and it's sinful wandering, to the promised land of heaven. The rousing tune PROMISED LAND is of uncertain authorship, and was first published in William Walker's book Southern Harmony in 1835. This tune is very simple and lively, and is arranged in our hymnal by Adventist musician Melvin West.

Another of our songs of worship is the familiar old hymn, *In a Little While We're Going Home,* Hymn number 626. This song was one that the hymnal committee "brought back" from the old Adventist hymn book, *Gospel in Song,* printed in 1926. At that time it was recorded as being copyrighted in 1899 by Hope Publishing Company, but little else is known about this hymn. Eliza Hewitt was a poet and musician and wrote both the words and the music for this song.

Postlude

Edward Mote was a cabinetmaker in London who was converted as a Christian at the early age of 16. One day in 1834, while walking to work, the idea came that he should write a hymn on the gracious experience of following Christ. The words

of the refrain formed in his mind, based on Jesus' parable from the sermon on the mount about the wise man



who "built his house upon a rock." Matthew 7:24. The sturdy tune was written in 1863 by William Bradbury, using very simple materials of three major chords. The Organ Postlude today is titled In Celebration: The Solid Rock, a joyous arrangement of this hymn by Gayden Sikes (words with Hymn No. 522). You are welcome to meditate on Hymn No. 522 as the music is played.
